REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration is now open for the 2018 Hillcrest Variety Show, to be held April 7th at the Tivoli Theatre, starting at 9:45 a.m.

The registration process has changed for this year, we're going digital! Please read carefully:

- Please choose **one ADULT** to register your child/children's act. If they're performing on their own, that's you! If they're in a group, one adult should be selected as the lead contact person. This person will act as the Act Coordinator and **register the group online, collect and turn in all signed permission slips for the group, and relay any Variety Show information back to the group.**

- The permission slip in this packet must be signed and returned to your Act Coordinator for **all performers** before February 14th.

FAQ's

What is the Hillcrest Variety Show?

The Variety Show is a chance for Hillcrest students to show off their talents and creativity on stage at the Tivoli Theater!

Who can perform in the Variety Show?

Any Hillcrest student can participate, either by themselves or in a group. Sorry, no adults or non-Hillcrest siblings may be included except under special circumstances.

What kind of acts are allowed?

Other than lip-syncing, students can perform just about anything that shows a talent or creativity, including singing, playing an instrument, dancing, skits, poetry readings, gymnastic routines, martial art routines, hula hooping... you get the drift!

How long are the acts?

Acts can be from 30 seconds to 90 seconds long. If your student is in a large group, extra time may be granted based on the act. Contact Annette or Kim for more information.

What kind of music can we use in the acts?

If your act includes music, both the clip you use in the act and the entire song content must be school appropriate. Final discretion will be with the Variety Show Chairpersons. Note that in order to avoid multiple acts performing the same song, each song may only be used by one act in the show. Song selection is first come, first serve, so choose quickly!

Can we use props?

Yes, as long as they can easily be taken on and off the stage. Students will be responsible for creating and supplying their props.
